

CLEAR OIL

Description:

Biohouse® CLEAR OIL can be used **as a clear finish** by itself for all kinds of wood where a clear satin, water repellent and natural surface is desired. It can also be used for outdoor if tinted with Biohouse Tinting Color. (as colorless finish do not provide UV protection)

It can also be used as primer on soft wood species, especially rough sawn wood, to equalize their absorbance capability before applying stains.

Product no.:

Surface treatment:

Wood surface must be clean, dry and frost free, maximum moisture content 20%. Old paints and varnishes must be sanded off. Final sanding of the bare wood should be sanded with sandpaper #120 or #180.

Application:

Ready to use . Please do not thin.

For indoor

Use bristle brush or cloth and apply one thin coat evenly and thoroughly along wood grain. Leave the surface to dry for 8-12 hours under good ventilation. Sand the dry surface with sandpaper #240 or #320. Apply the second coat with the same method.

For outdoor

Apply adequately and evenly with bristle brush along wood grain. Leave the surface to dry for 8-12 hours. Apply the second coat with the same method.

Drying time: (20°C,RH50%,Provide good ventilation)

Dust dry: approx. 8 hours

Workable after approx. 24-48 hours

Final hardness after approx. 2 weeks

Coverage:

For indoor

30-45m² / L per coat

For outdoor

hard wood: 15-20m² / L per coat

soft wood: 10-15m² / L per coat

Packing:

Available in 0.75L, 2.5L and 10L metal cans.

Tool cleaning:

Use **biohouse® Superclean Thinner 100**.

Content:

Based on natural vegetable oils, lead free siccativ, disaromatized isoparaffin.

Pot life:

Can be stored above 3 years if can is full and tightly closed.

Caution:

Solid cloths should be spread out dry and not crumpled together(danger of self-ignition by the drying oils).

Store out of the reach of children. Store cool place. Hazard class: does not apply

Disposal:

Dried product residues can be composted or put into the household waster. Liquid paint residues: EAK waste code 200112;EAK classification : paints. Packing material : Tin-plate. Empty containers can be recycled.
